


Centennial United Methodist Church at Ivy

On March 19th, 2018 a Charge Conference was held to vote on transitioning Centennial to a full-time pastoral appointment. The vote passed with 34 'Yes' votes and 15 'No' votes. Centennial will be transitioning to a full-time pastoral appointment! 
